

French is used in 30 countries in Africa. Some of them are the continent’s poorest. Africa is home to 19 of the world’s 20 youngest populations. 41% of the continent’s population is under 15 years of age. Most African countries have a growth rate of 2% or more, which prompts some language experts to say that French could become the world’s most used language during this century.

Synergie Francophone’s Sunday school curriculum, specially adapted for populations that are oral or where children have little or no schooling, has seen great success not only in Africa – for which it was designed – but in other French-speaking parts of the world such as Haiti, where only 50% of children attend school. Churches report that the first impact of the curriculum is on the teachers. Their own Bible knowledge and insight grow as they unpack the stories with the help of the teachers’ manuals, and as they plan and gather visual aids to help the children understand the stories and applications.

The children love the lessons and roleplaying so much that they don't want to miss a Sunday!



The curriculum is divided into 3 age ranges:

Level 1: Children of 4 to 8 years

Level 2: Children of 8 to 11 years

Level 3: Preteens and teens of 12 to 15 years

There are several manuals for each level, each containing 26 lessons, a weekly lesson for six months of Sundays.

Beautiful hand-drawn illustrations accompany Levels 1 and 2 to help children understand life in Bible times.



The children are taught to roleplay the stories and the applications. After the class, many children roleplay the stories and applications in their communities. Their friends like that so much that they start coming to Sunday school.
