No Longer Under a Curse

SF partner David Langford finished his classes with theological students in Dungu, then flew to Bunia with Mission Aviation Fellowship last Thursday for two weeks of seminars and meetings. He returns home from the DRC March 22nd. David interviewed each of his students to hear their stories. Jean Paul had an alcoholic mother who died when he was a teenager. A family member pronounced that no one would finish high school; believing this curse, Jean Paul left before completing his education. In 2013, he heard the Gospel and realized he no longer needed to live under the curse. He earned his high school diploma, received evangelism training from Samaritan's Purse, and wanted to be on a missions team to help renew churches.
