SF Is in France!

On Saturday, France Impressions Team (FIT) members ministered to children and seniors, using testimony, songs, and SF Executive Director Angela Brandle's children's stories that the "big kids" enjoyed too. At church, two FIT singers gave beautiful solos, a colleague shared a testimony, and Angela spoke—all in French! The church invited them to a picnic in a beautiful setting, sharing a great array of food. Last night, a couple invited three FIT members to a home group to share testimonies, followed by a feast on their vine-covered patio: several courses, each one eaten slowly as they enjoyed relaxing, blessed fellowship together.

The team is working hard at the print shop. It is very hot and very noisy! Angela is working with one of the directors to help him apply for grants in English and connecting with SF missionaries the Phillips. Please continue to pray for the FIT as they serve.

SF's France Impressions Team is now in Montélimar serving with our partner IMÉAF, the only evangelical Christian print shop in France. IMÉAF is celebrating 60 years of printing God's Word, as well as biblical books, magazines, tracts, calendars, brochures, and much more to further God's work through the printed word around the French-speaking world. They have printed and shipped 350 million pieces of literature including 16 million books and 30 million Gospels. Praise God for this.

Last week, IMÉAF printed four and a half million tracts! To help continue this ministry, please pray for...

- \$100,000 in gift income to provide them with an operational fund. They are having financial challenges.
- Safety of the workers operating or working around machines.
- Better health for the director and his deputy (both with acute back problems), the workshop manager (diagnosed with a strange disease that could poison his blood), a graphic designer (still recovering from a motorcycle accident and needing to regain full use of his hand), the other graphic designer (SF missionary Nathan Phillips who had an MS attack in January).
- Machines to function well.
- Millions of people who will read these tracts explaining the way to be right with God.
