#### Why Quebec?

- The Quebecois are the largest unreached people in both North and South America.
- In Montréal alone, to reach a ratio of 1 evangelical church for every 30,000 people, 50 new church plants are needed.
- The Quebecois hold more unfavorable views of religion than anyone anywhere else in Canada.
- There is only one evangelical church for every 106,000 people.

# Reaching Quebec


We want to reach over seven million French speakers in Quebec by setting up 100 Christian FM radio stations. One hundred people or church groups who give \$600/year can make it happen.

The mother-station near Quebec City broadcasts in French and provides the programming for future stations. Great Bible teachers are explaining God's Word and his way of salvation over the airwaves, along with good music.

A station built in a church in Brownsburg-Chatham, 55 miles northwest of Montréal, is broadcasting to 85,000 households; 89 more will be needed to cover all of Quebec.
