Magazine Training International (MTI) seeks to encourage and strengthen Christian magazine publishers in the developing world as they seek to build the Church and reach their societies for Christ. SF is partnering with MTI to make this happen.





Training in Africa

Building on the experience of its first two conferences in Africa–Kenya in 2018 (for English-speakers) and Côte d'Ivoire in 2019 (for French-speakers)–MTI offered a bilingual conference in Ghana in 2022. As a translator for the conferences in Côte d'Ivoire and Ghana, SF Executive Director Angela Brandle witnessed the quality of the training and the enthusiasm of the participants, who attended optional evening sessions and stayed late into the night for consulting sessions.

More than 70 Christian magazine publishing professionals from eight French-speaking African countries came for the intensive seven-day "Introduction to Magazine Publishing." The course, which included a brand-new text book, covered three primary emphases: the basics of magazine publishing, starting a magazine, and digital publishing. Each emphasis included magazine editing, design, and management topics taught by a team of six experienced magazine editors, designers, and publishers from the US and Kenya.
