In 2006, Clement Kroeker (the son of SF's founders) and his wife Charlotte founded Congo Open Heart, a ministry dedicated to giving much-needed Bibles in French to francophone believers in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC). In 2023, the Kroekers passed the baton of their ministry to SF.

Our Mission

Congolese pastors and evangelists travel by dugout canoe, boat, plane, motorcycle, and foot to distribute Bibles to the remote fringes of the DRC. These committed leaders brave hazardous roads, lack of transportation, driving accidents, threat of carjacking, illnesses like malaria, and other dangers to place Bibles into the hands of believers who have none.

Our Vision

For 17 years, Congo Open Heart helped to reach communities with God's Word in 7 of the DRC's provinces--yet 19 remain. The largest country in sub-Saharan Africa with an area about the size of western Europe, the DRC still has an immense need for Bibles. Our vision is to see a Bible in the hands of every believer in the DRC.
