



## **Another SF Grant Request Approved**

After months of prayerfully considering more requests than it could fund, the **Tyndale House Foundation board approved a grant to our partners at the Oasis print-on-demand center in Kinshasa, DRC, in the amount of \$15,000**. We praise God for this generous allocation, considering that the board received so many requests this year that they warned grants would likely be smaller than previously. Please continue to pray for this Congolese-led ministry as it seeks to become self-sustaining in printing much-needed biblical resources to equip the African church.

# **Equipping the Congolese Church**

SF partner David Langford flies to the DRC January 27th for six weeks of discipling leaders to disciple more leaders. For the past 14 years, David has been working with three local pastors to cultivate renewal and health in more than 1,700 congregations in Northeast Congo. To that end, David will co-teach a course on "Advanced Christian Education" to 21 theology students at SF partner Hope University (Université Batîssons l'Espoir au Centre de l'Afrique [UBECA]), coaching a team in Dungu who will lead seminars on church development, facilitating discussions with church leaders on combatting substance abuse, recording six expositions on Malachi for radio, and following up with the Adopt a High School project. **Fifty-seven libraries are en route**
