Ministry Story

For over 23 years, Fabrice and Sylviane have been full-time workers in the harvest, spreading the Gospel through literature. The French couple left their jobs in 2002 to study at the Geneva Bible Institute. Then they served with the Belgian Evangelical Mission at The Good Book, a Christian bookshop in Brussels, and worked closely with the Brussels Bible Institute (IBB).

They now design and create biblically rich books at Christian publishing house Éditions Clé in France. Here Fabrice uses his expert skills in IT and graphic design, while Sylviane edits all books and checks Bible references, quotations, and facts. Passionate about the importance of solid biblical training, Fabrice serves at IBB as a professor and board president.

Why Publishing Ministry Matters

It is often worldly thinking, not the Bible, that shapes churches. But Fabrice and Sylviane are defending sound doctrine and sharing the Gospel through helping to publish quality biblical literature. They are among a very few workers in the field of Christian publishing in France, one of the world’s most secular nations.

As a university student, Fabrice, a staunch atheist, started reading the Bible to uncover all of its errors. But through a year and a half of reading, he came to realize that God exists and that he needed to confess his sins and put his trust in Jesus. Reading Job, he finally entrusted his life to the Lord.
